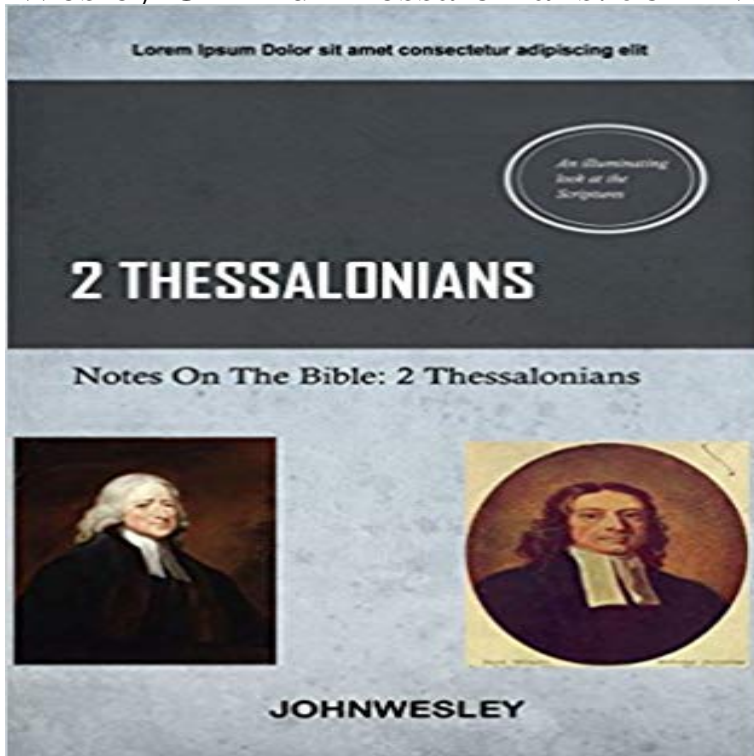


Wesley On 2nd Thessalonians: John Wesley's Notes On The Bible
