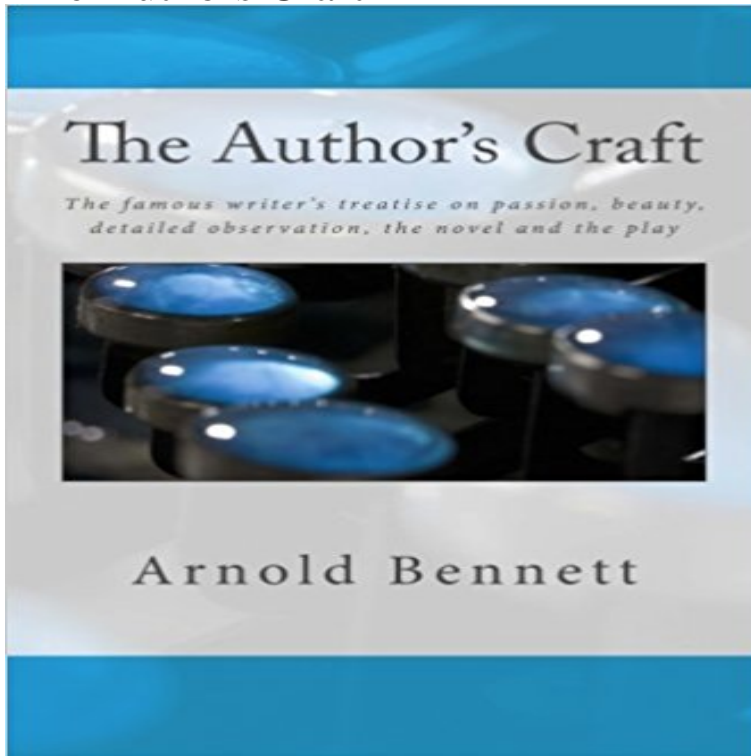


## The Authors Craft

He doesn't get into technique other than to expound on the need for design or construction to follow inspiration. He writes with passion; indeed he mentions that passion is one of the two essential characteristics of the novelist. The other key attribute being a sense of beauty. He also discusses the key differences between writing novels and writing plays - having written about twenty of each. The artist who yields is lost. The author of *The Grand Babylon Hotel*, *How to Live on 24 Hours a Day*, *The Old Wives Tale* and much more, English writer Arnold Bennett's fictional and non-fictional works have stood the test of time. Bennett also wrote for stage and screen. *The Authors Craft*, contains some of Bennett's essays on the art of writing, with his thoughts on applying the craft to both novel and play writing. First published in 1914, *The Authors Craft* reveals the essence of what Bennett learned as a practicing writer; namely, the importance of detailed observation, the art of writing a novel, the art of play writing, and how a writer can best please his public.
