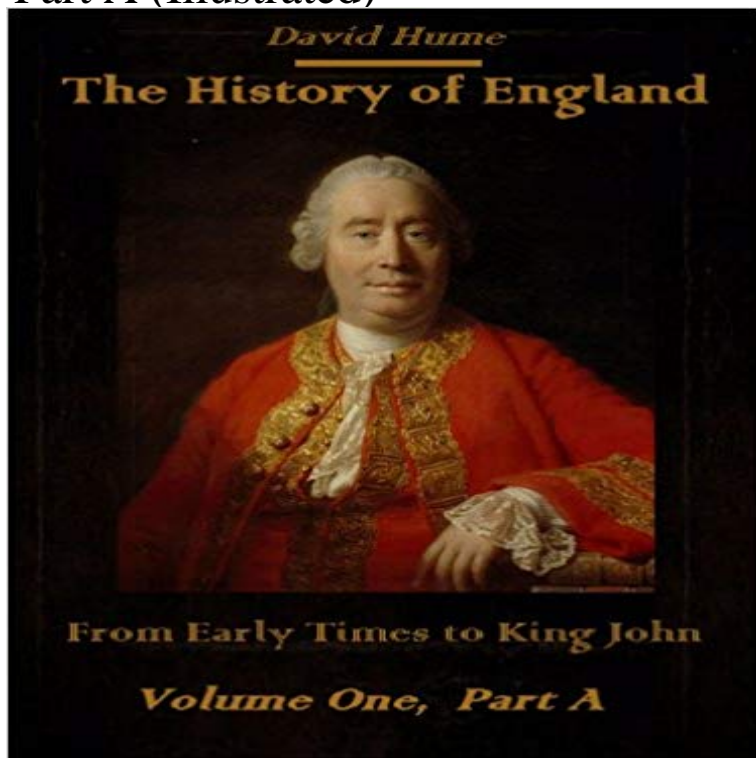


The History of England : From Early Times to King John, Volume One, Part A (Illustrated)
