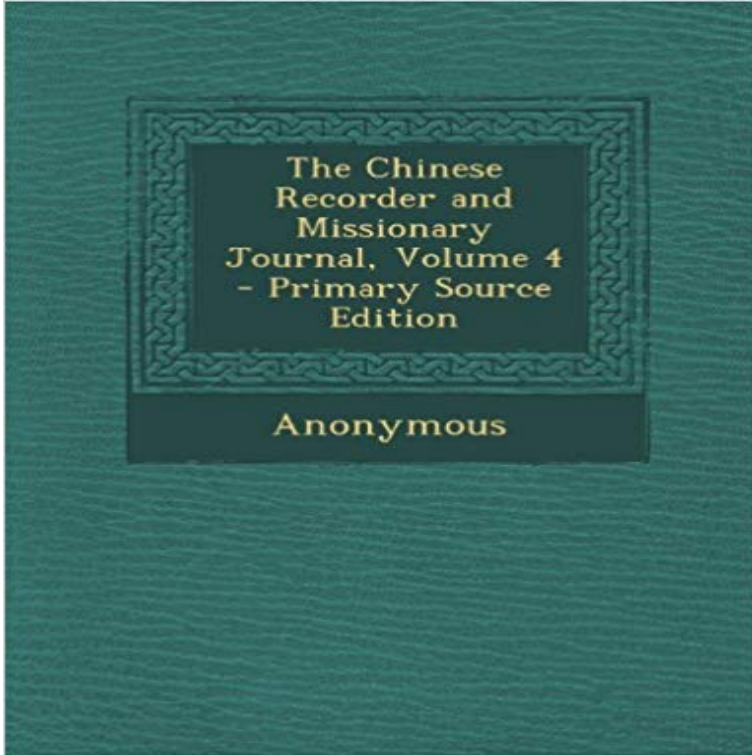


The Chinese Recorder and Missionary Journal, Volume 4 - Primary Source Edition
