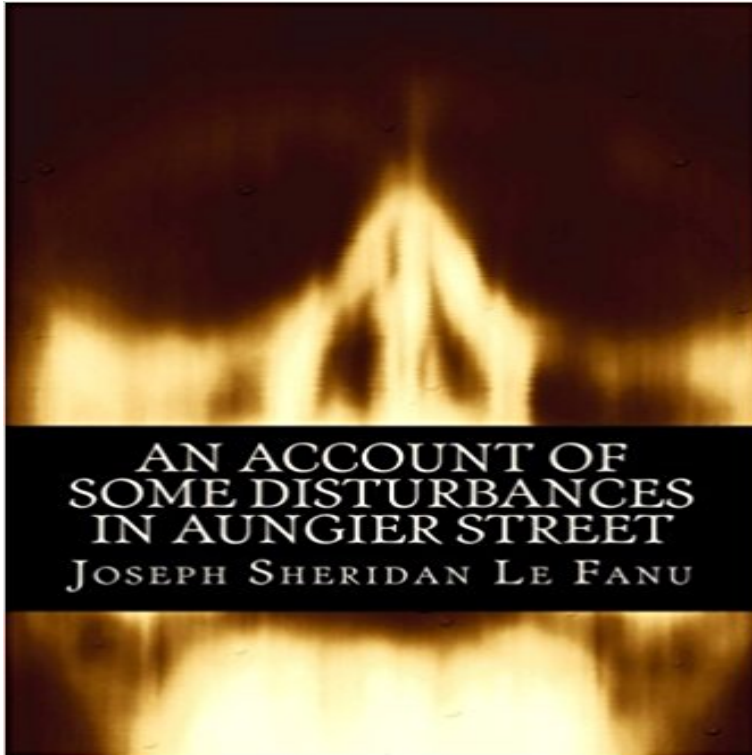


An Account of Some Disturbances in Aungier Street



Considered the father of the English ghost story, Irish writer and magazine editor Joseph Sheridan Le Fanu was well-known for his supernaturalist and mystery fiction (famous examples of the latter being Uncle Silas and The Rose and the Key). One of the major figures of supernaturalism, LeFanu helped move supernaturalist fiction away from the Gothics emphasis on external sources of terror and toward a focus on the effects of terror, thus helping to create the psychological basis for supernaturalist and horror literature that continues today.
