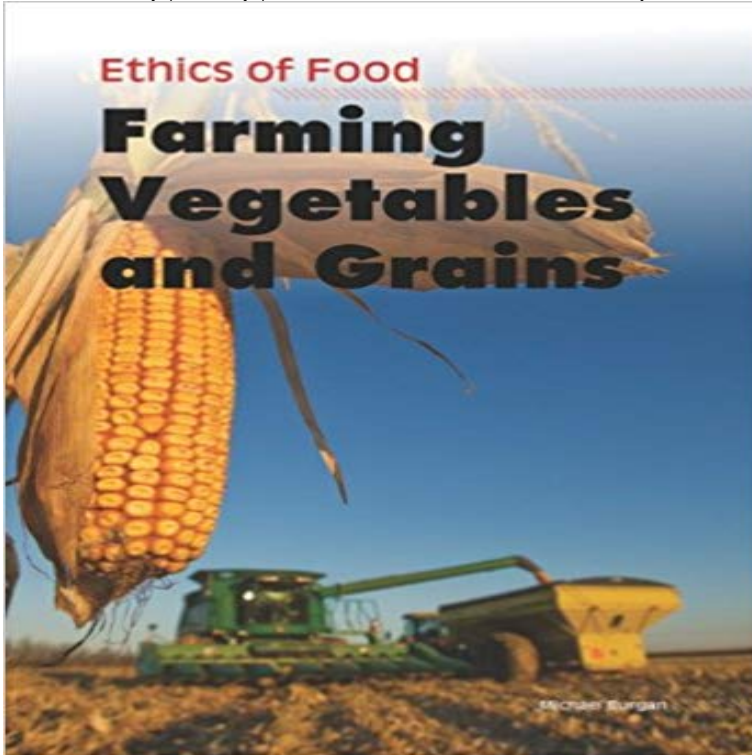


Farming Vegetables and Grains (Ethics of Food)
