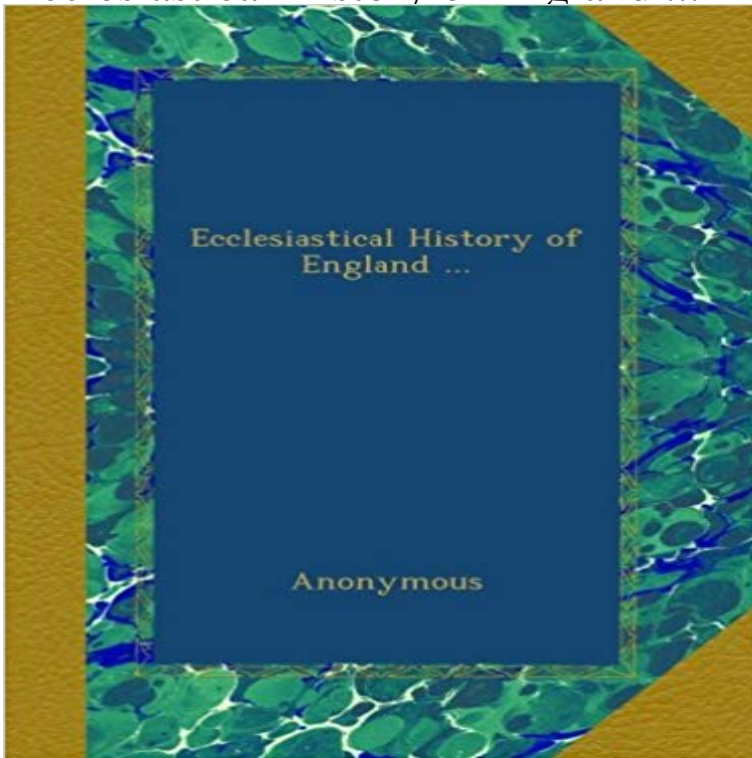


## Ecclesiastical History of England ...
