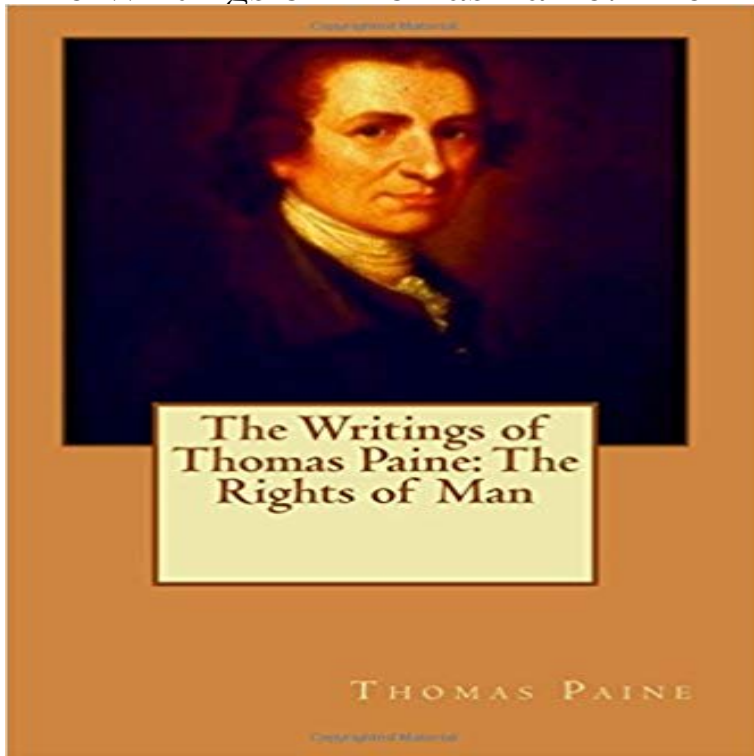


## The Writings of Thomas Paine: The Rights of Man
