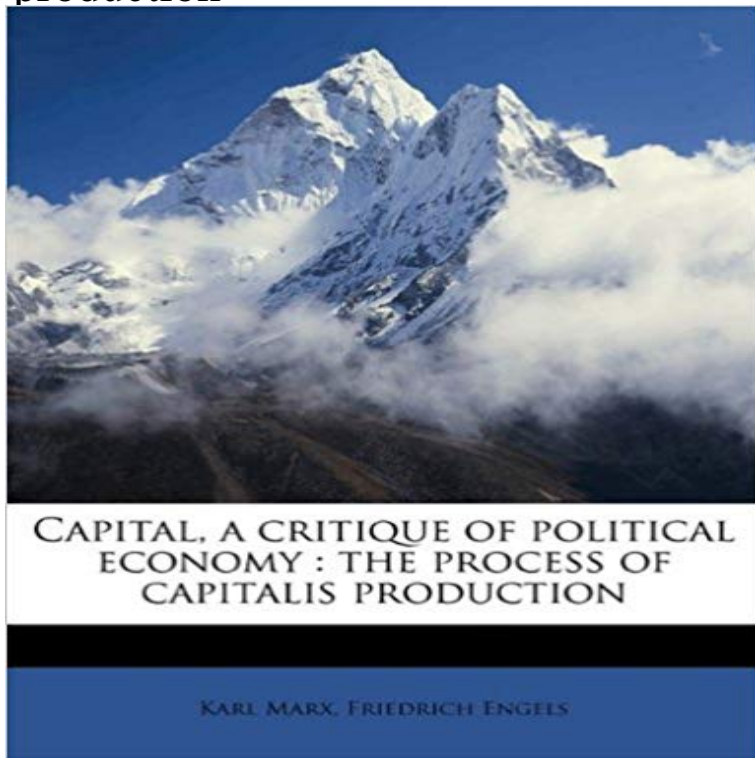


Capital, a critique of political economy: the process of capitalis production
