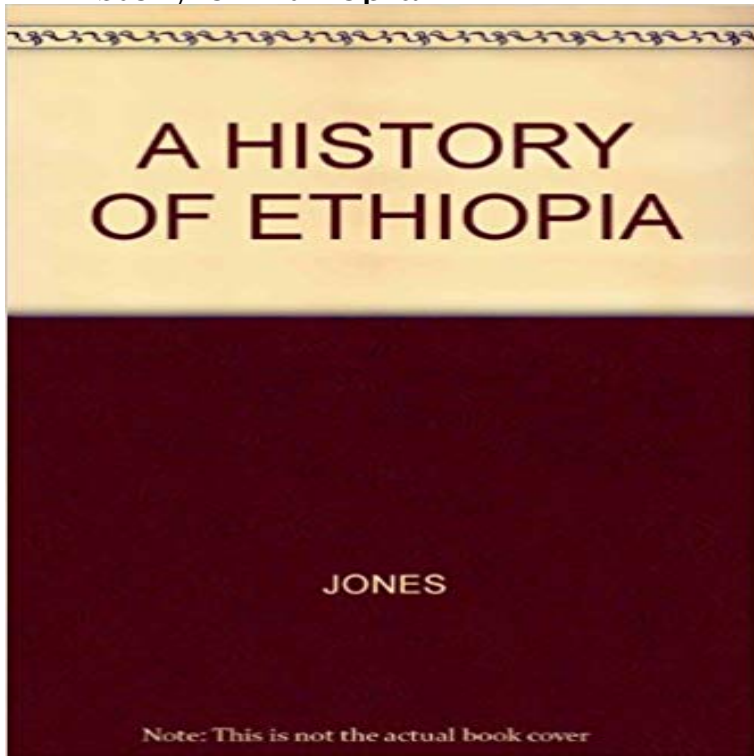


A history of Ethiopia
