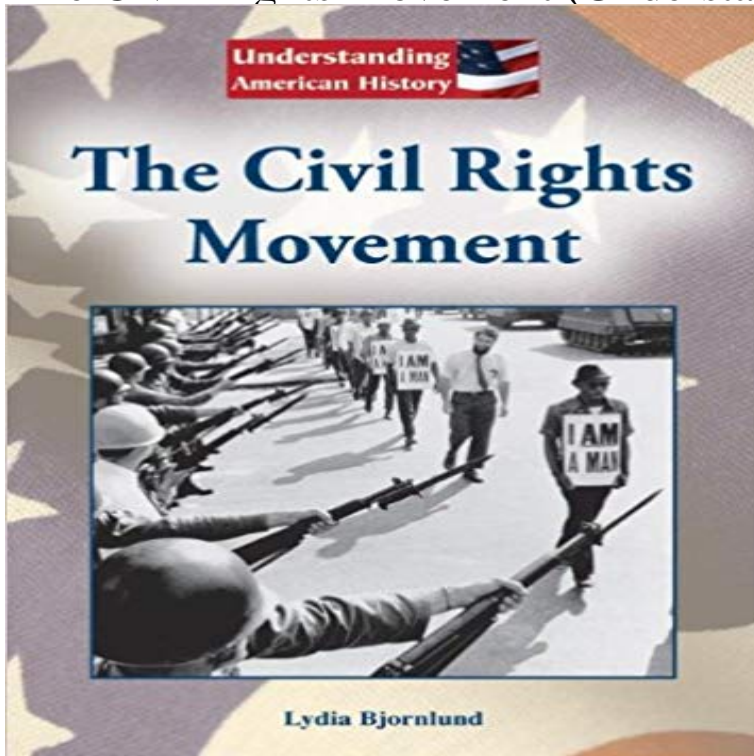


# The Civil Rights Movement (Understanding American History)
