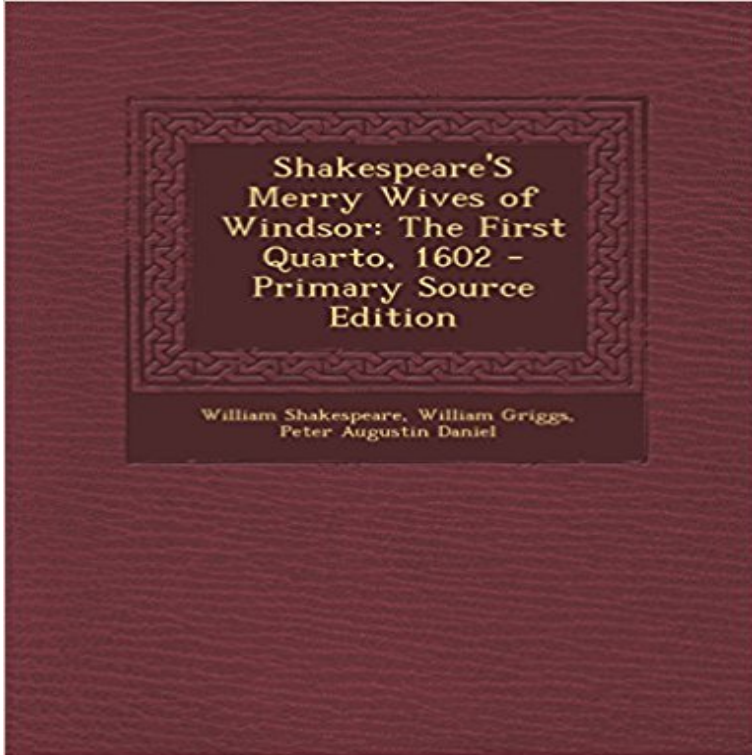


# Shakespeares Merry Wives of Windsor: The First Quarto, 1602 - Primary Source Edition
