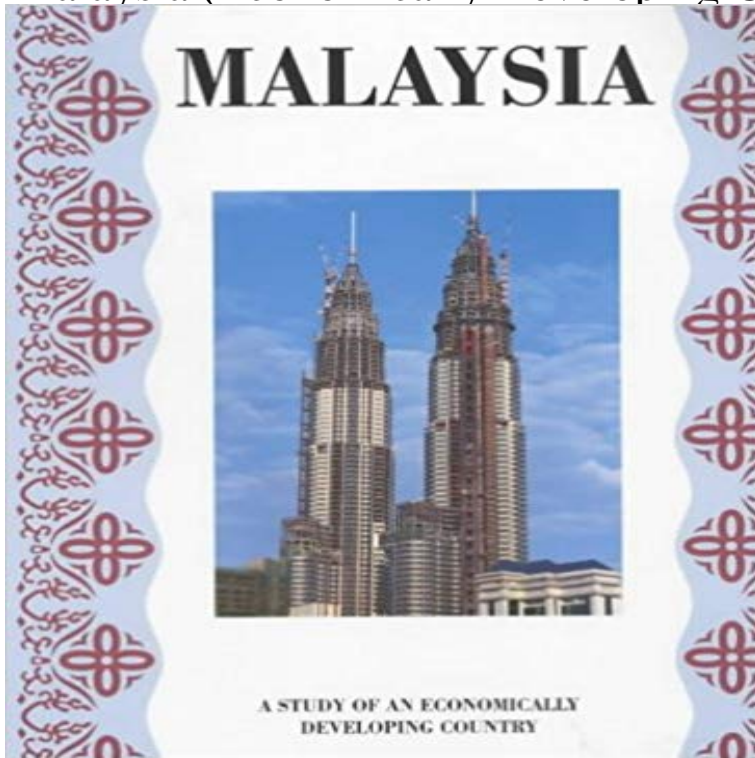


## Malaysia (Economically Developing Countries)
