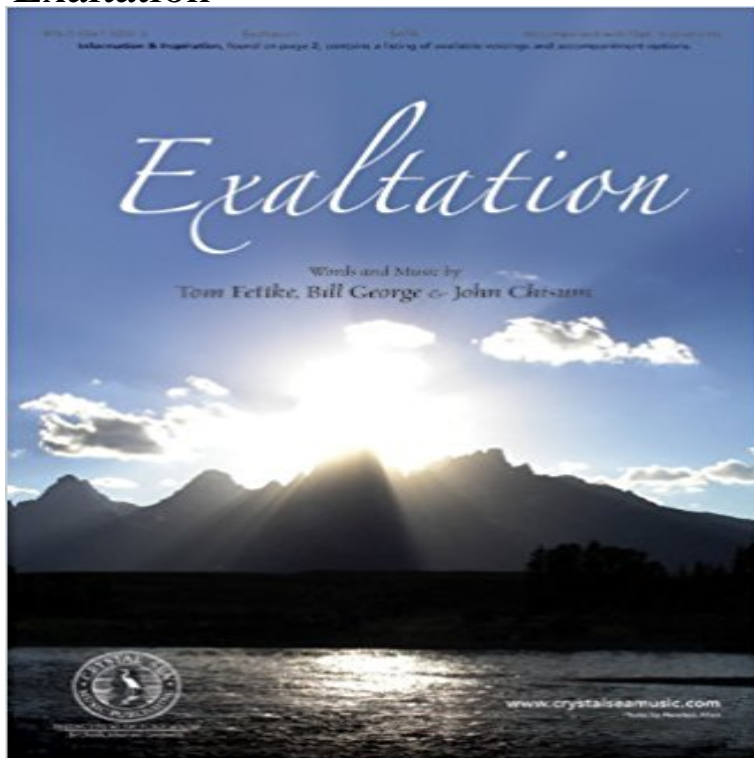


Exaltation
