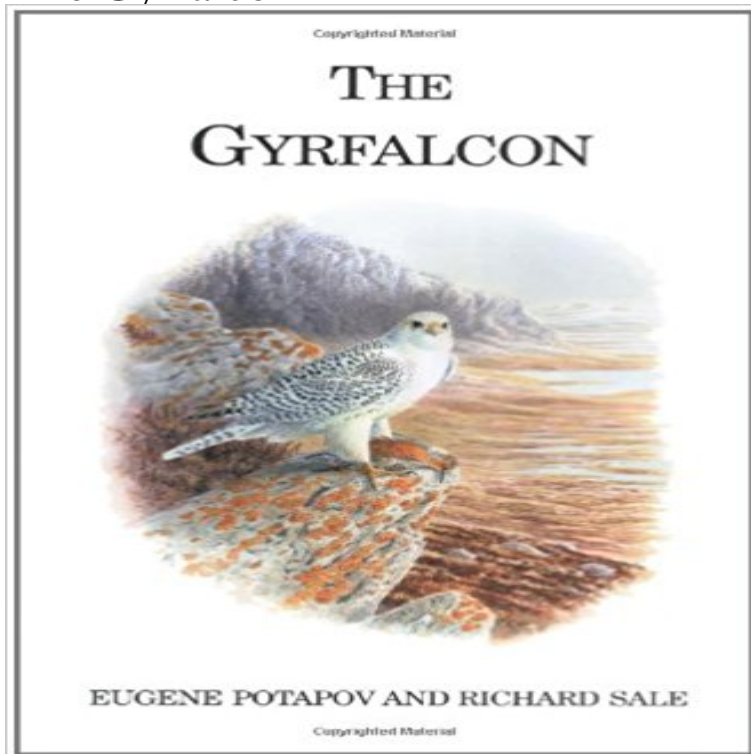


The Gyrfalcon
