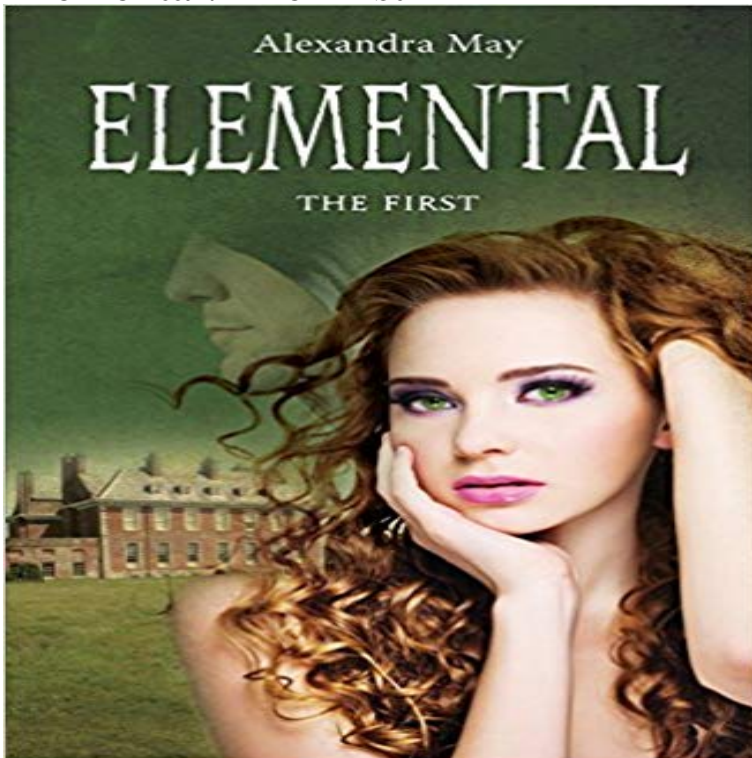


Elemental: The First
