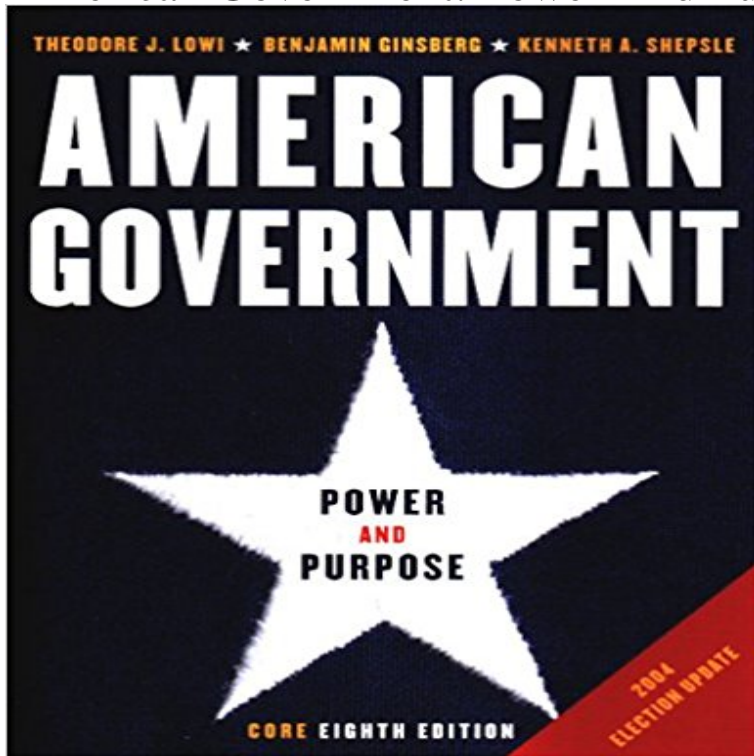


American Government: Power And Purpose: Core 2004 Election Update
