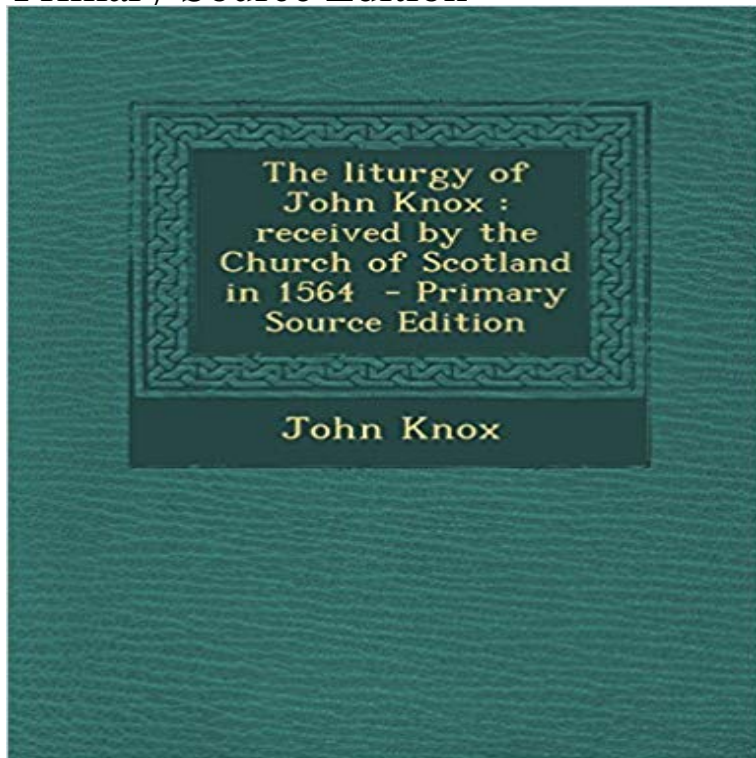


The Liturgy of John Knox: Received by the Church of Scotland in 1564 - Primary Source Edition
