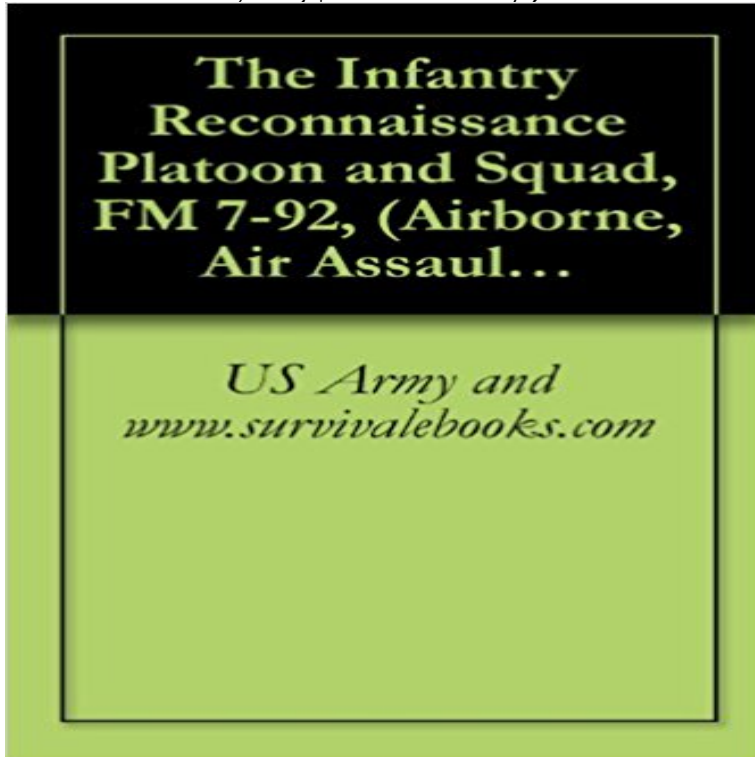


# The Infantry Reconnaissance Platoon and Squad, FM 7-92, (Airborne, Air Assault, Light Infantry)



This manual describes the doctrinal and tactical employment of thereconnaissance platoon in airborne, air assault, and light infantry battalions. It provides the reconnaissance platoons leaders with tactics, techniques, and procedures to exploit its reconnaissance and security capabilities, to reduce its vulnerabilities, and to enable its parent battalion to obtain the information necessary to win on the battlefield. This manual also provides guidance for employing the reconnaissance platoon or infantry platoons that conduct reconnaissance and security operations. The estimate of the situation determines how to apply the doctrine in this manual. Although this manual does not implement any international agreements, the material presented herein is in accordance with related international agreements.
