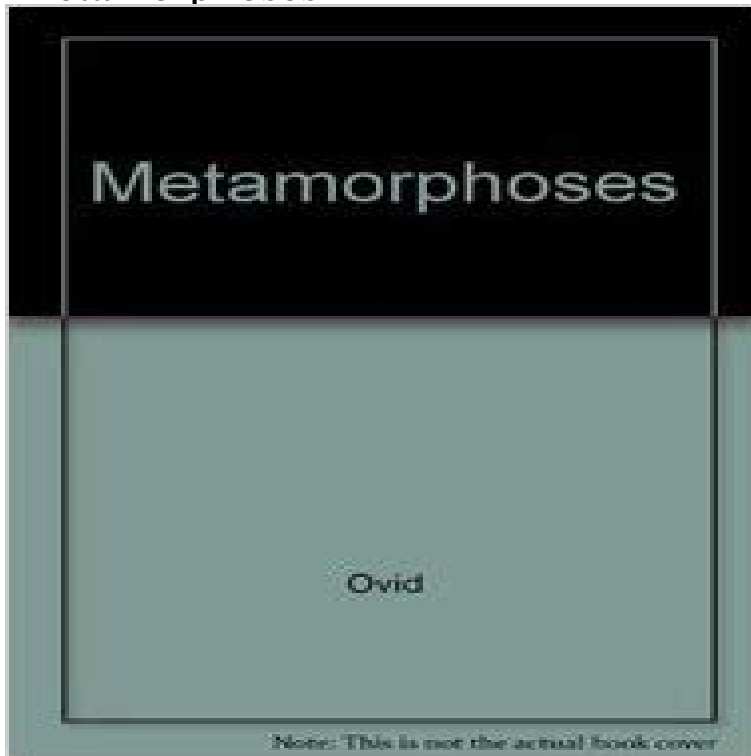


# Metamorphoses



One of the greatest and most influential texts of antiquity, the *Metamorphoses* is universally regarded as Ovid's highest poetical achievement. Divided into 15 books dealing with the creation of the world, earth, its phenomena, and a host of Greek myths and legends, Ovid's book has ingrained itself into the collective mind of Western culture, sparking an infinite number of imitations and spin-off works to the present day. Rolfe Humphreys' faithful blank-verse translation of the originals hexameters shows a definite kinship for Ovid's swift and colloquial language, and a poetical manner in tune with the wit and sophistication of the Roman poet. Through Humphreys' version, the modern reader will be able to rediscover a major treasury of classical mythology which has perennially stimulated the imagination.

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
