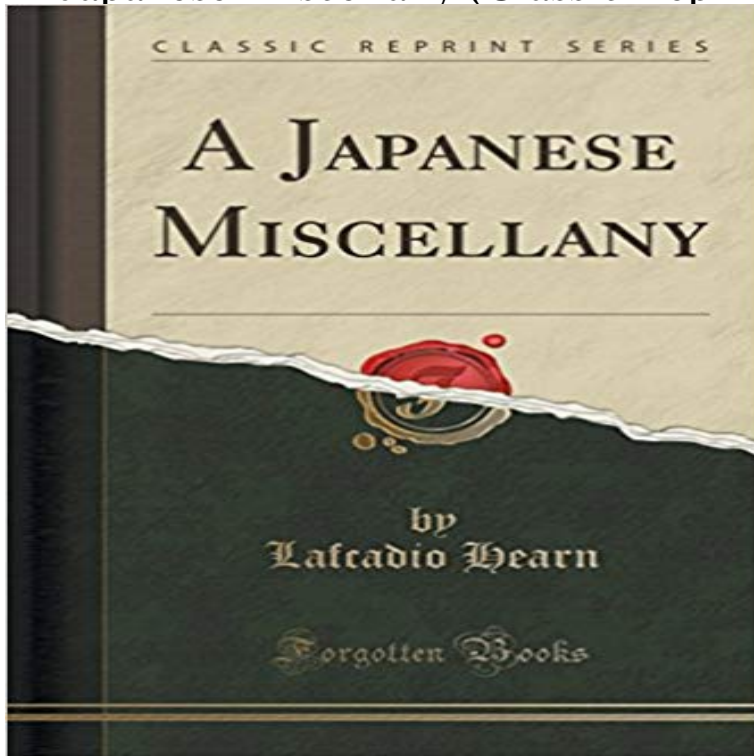


A Japanese Miscellany (Classic Reprint)
