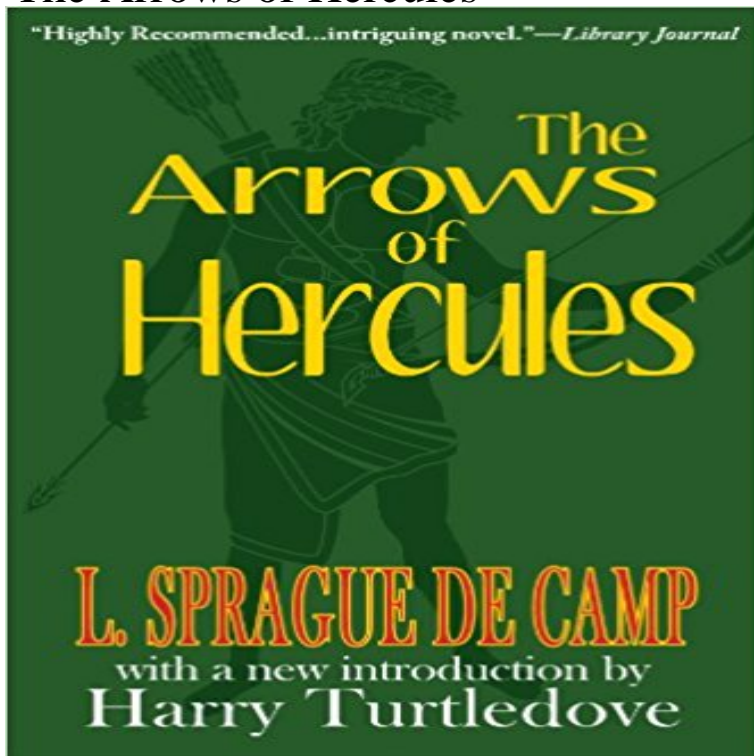


The Arrows of Hercules
