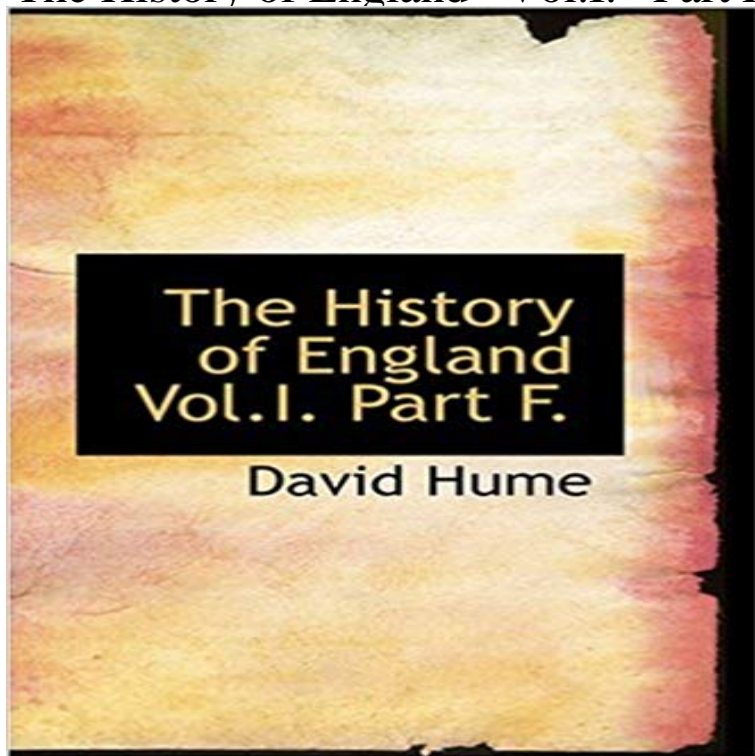


The History of England Vol.I. Part F.
