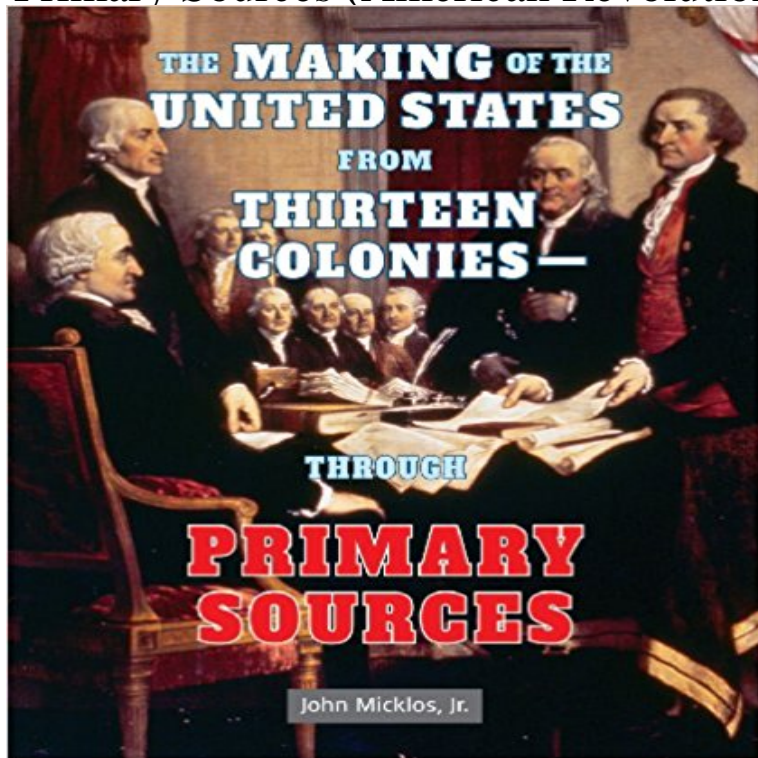


The Making of the United States from Thirteen Colonies - Through Primary Sources (American Revolution Through Primary Sources)
