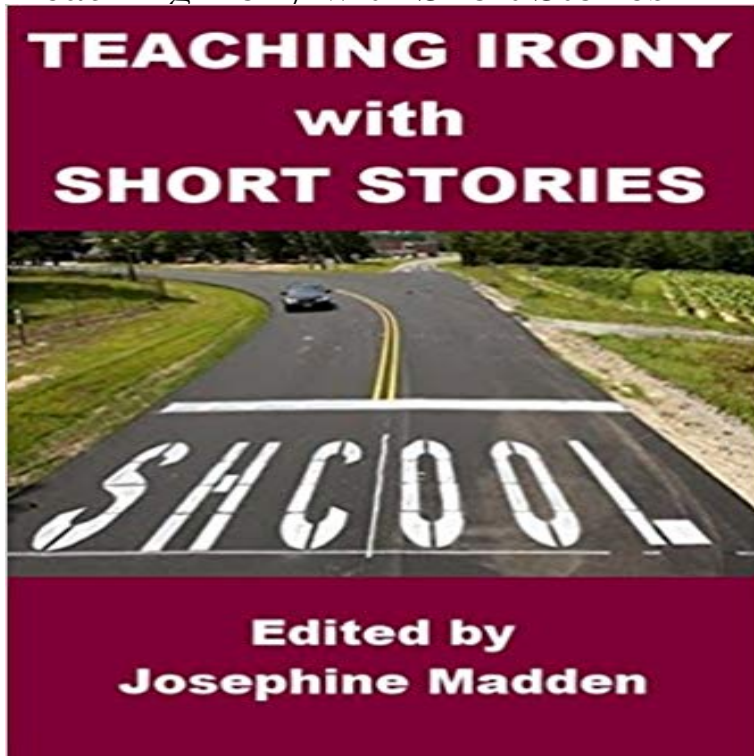


## Teaching Irony with Short Stories
