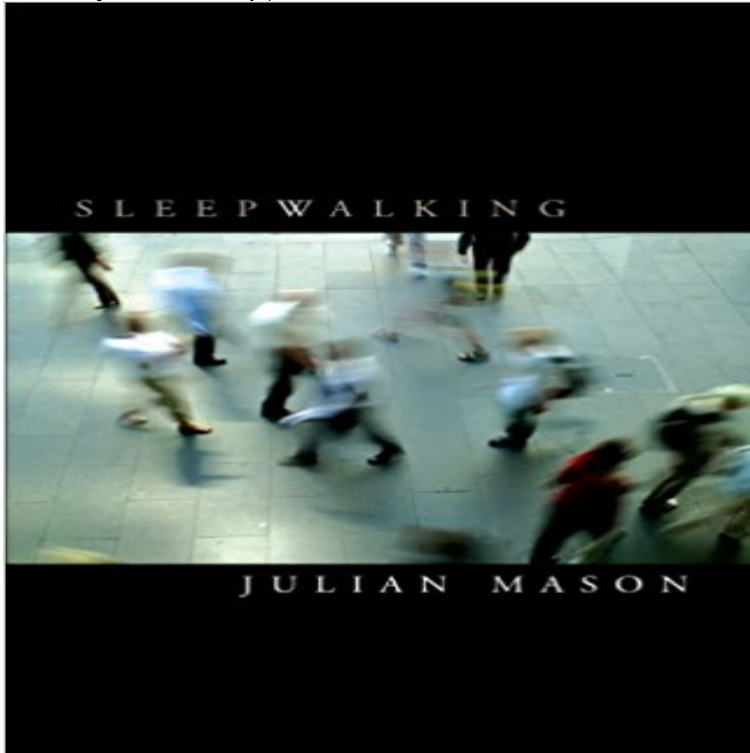


## Sleepwalking
