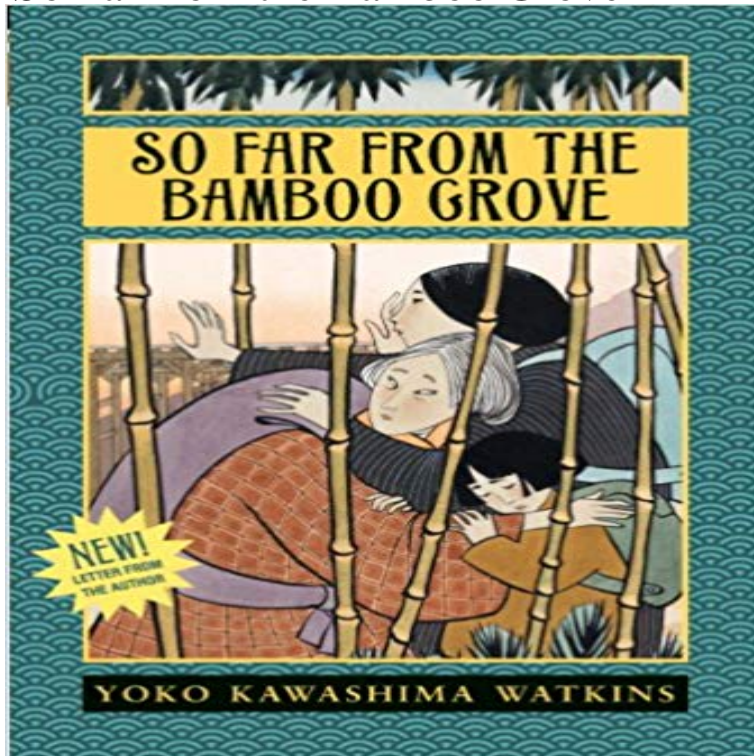


So Far from the Bamboo Grove
