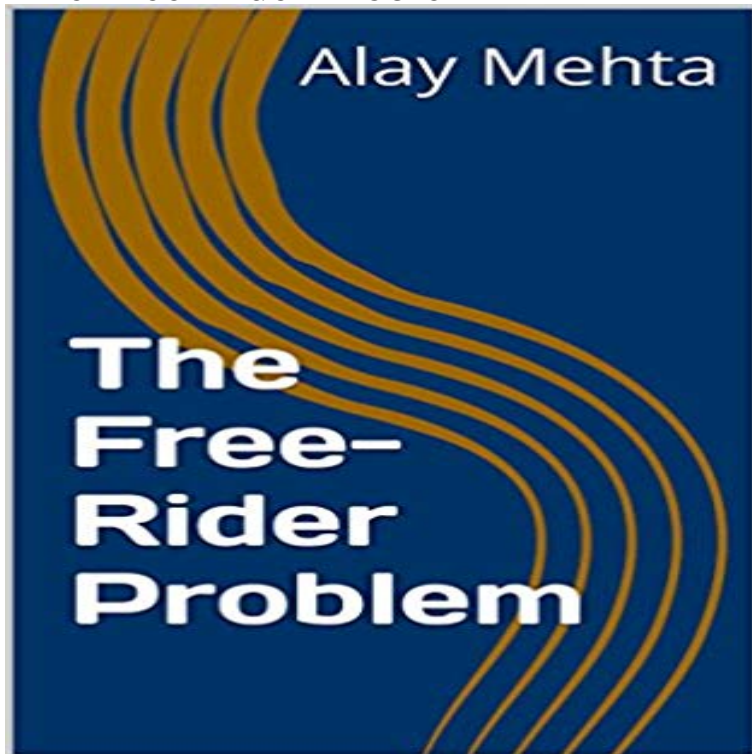


The Free-Rider Problem
