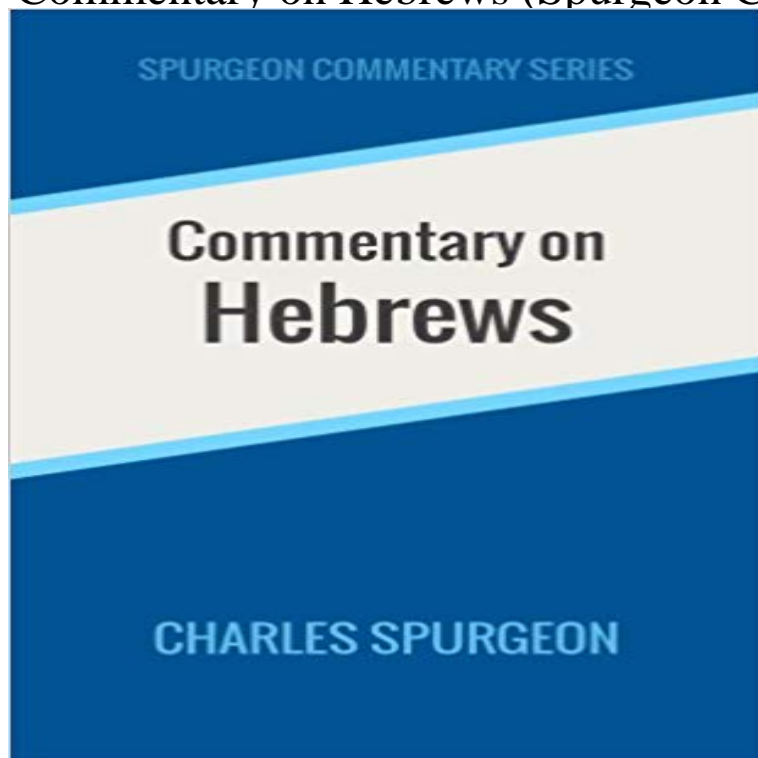


Commentary on Hebrews (Spurgeon Commentary Series)

need a complete new creation as I certainly do he is equal to the task.
