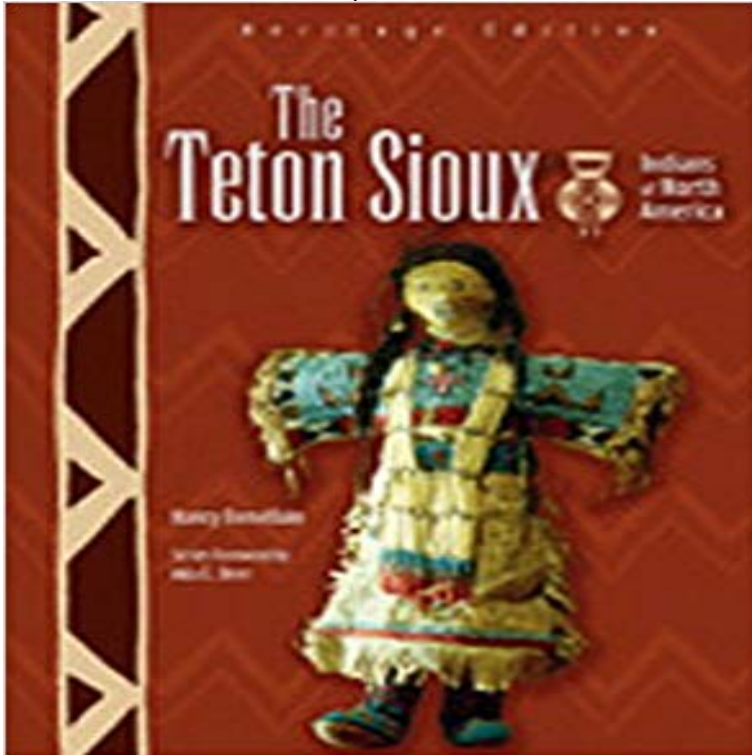


## The Teton Sioux (Indians of North America)
