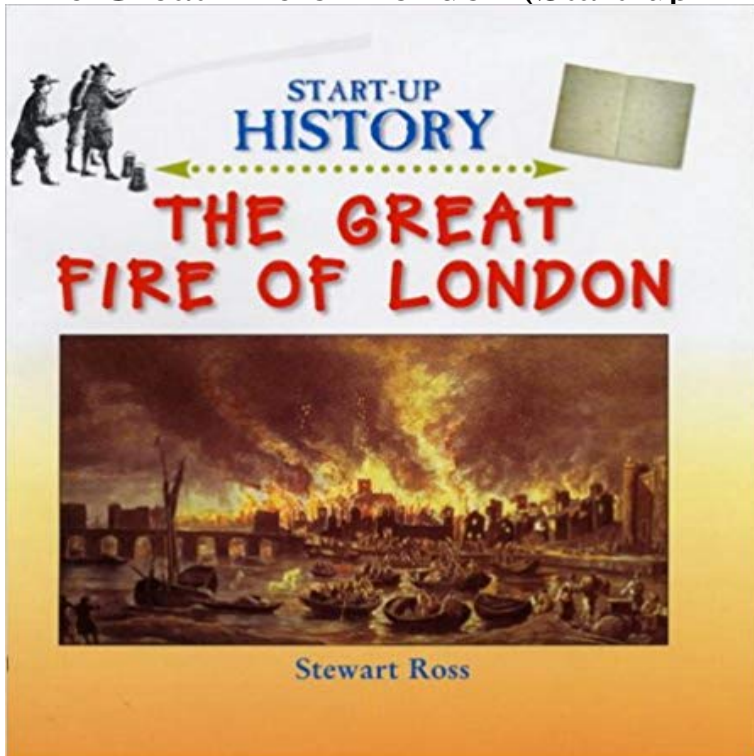


## The Great Fire of London (Start-up History)
