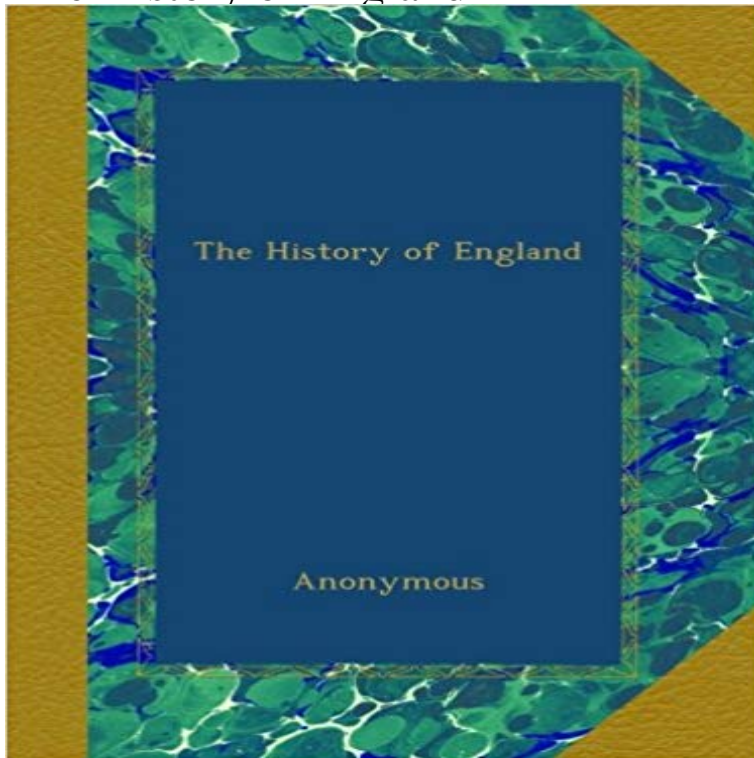


# The History of England
