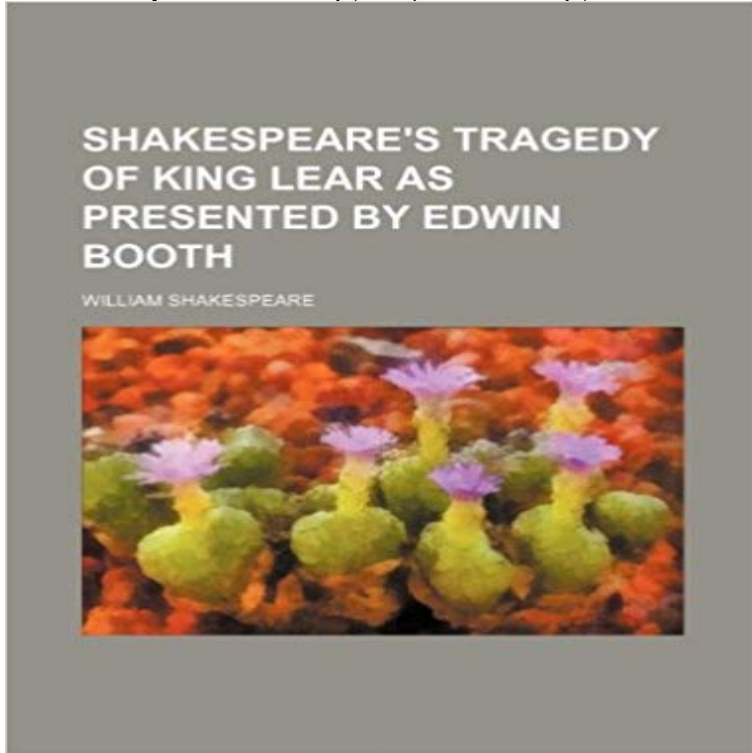


## Shakespeares tragedy of King Lear as presented by Edwin Booth
