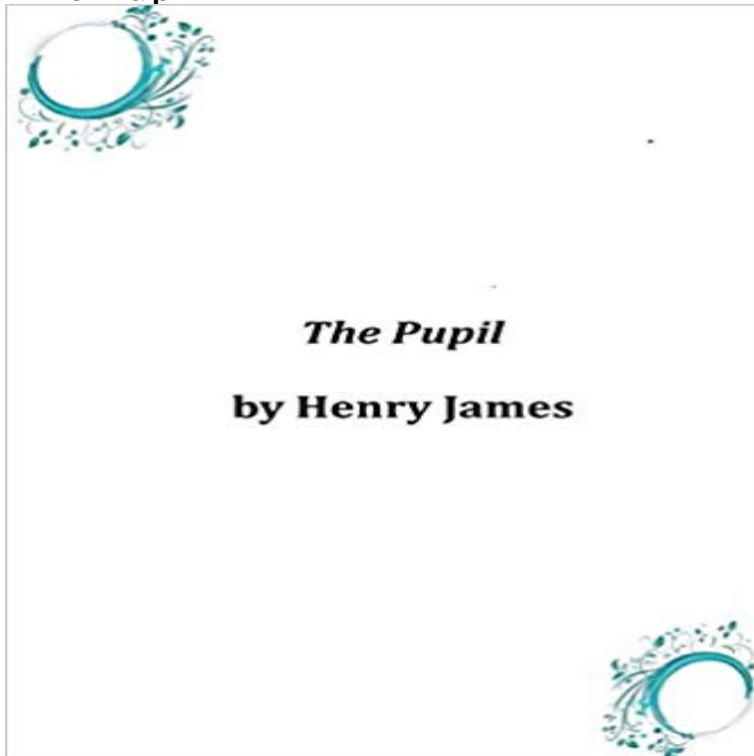


# The Pupil
