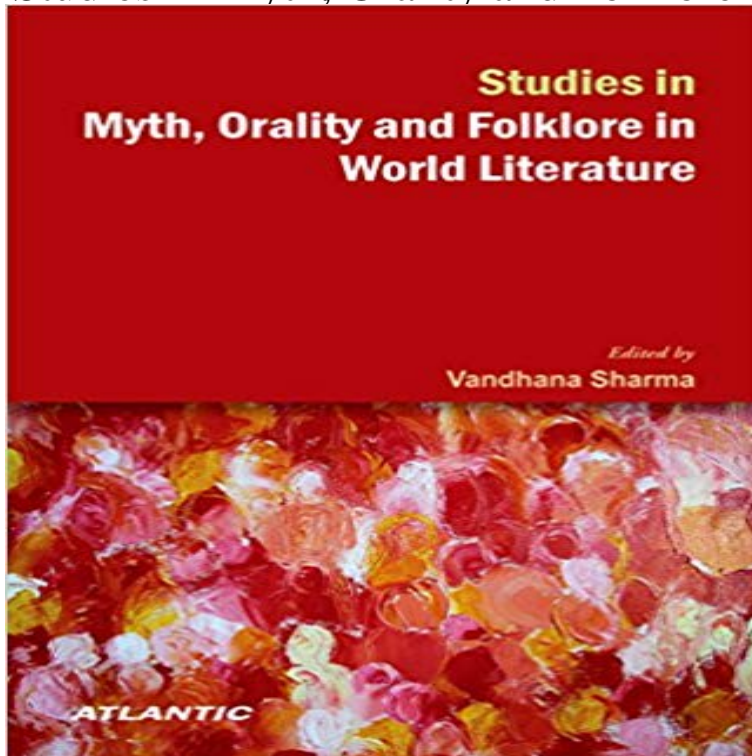


Studies in Myth, Orality and Folklore in World Literature
