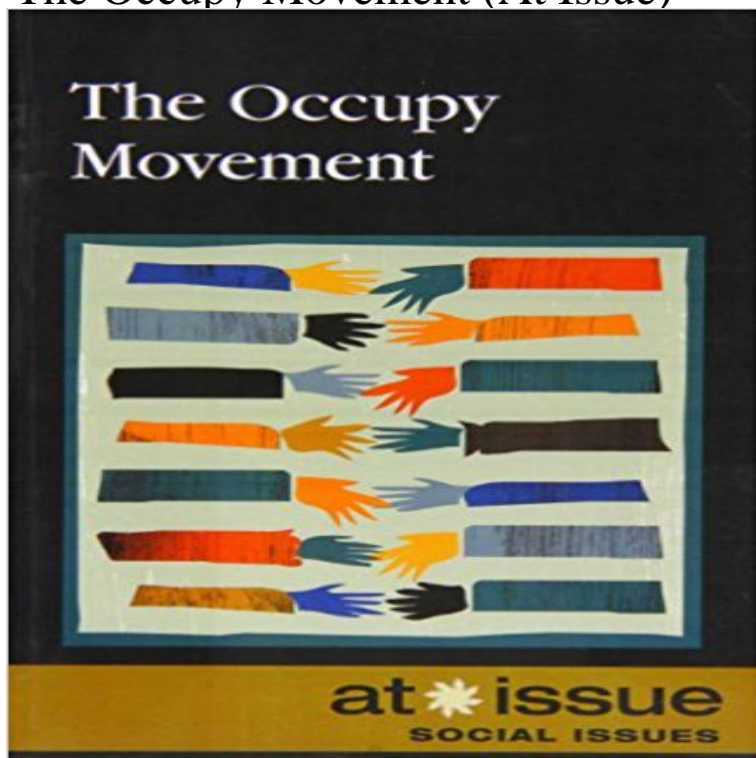


The Occupy Movement (At Issue)
