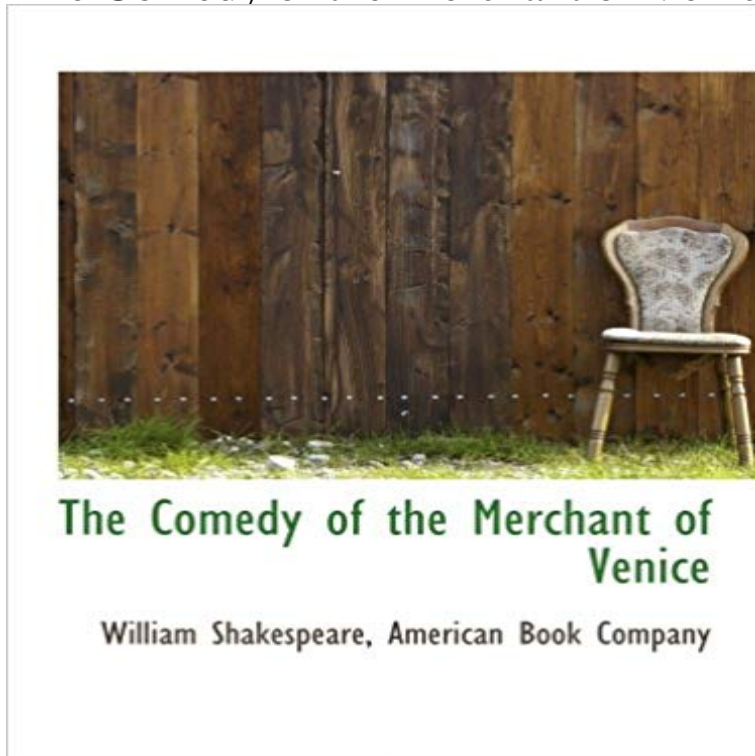


The Comedy of the Merchant of Venice
