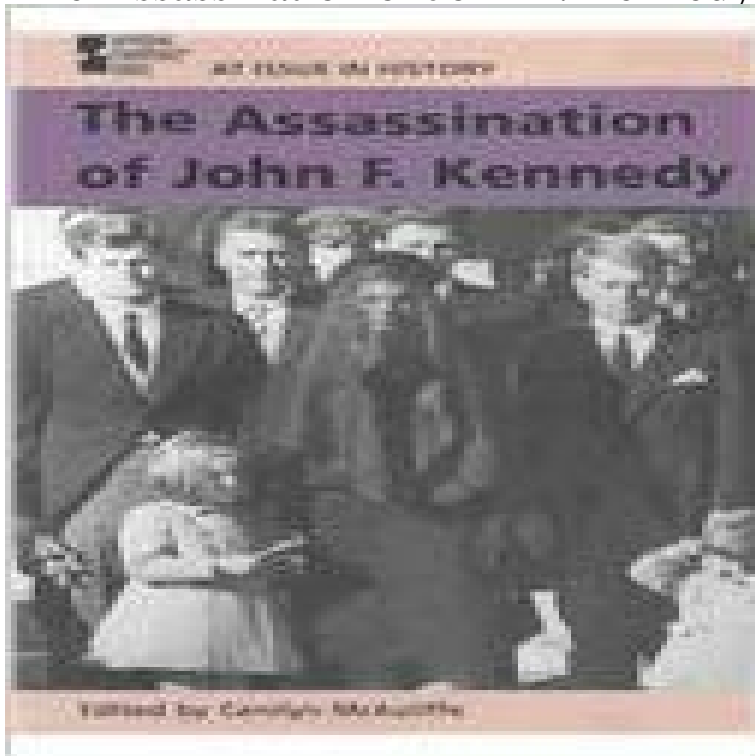


The Assassination of John F. Kennedy (At Issue in History)
